MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BY AND BETWEEN

MAHAKAUSHAL UNIVERSITY, JABALPUR (M.P.) AND BUNDELKHAND UNIVERSITY, JHANSI (U.P.)

This memorandum of understanding (MoU) is between the Mahakaushal University, Jabalpur and the Bundelkhand University, Jhansi to facilitate a formal tie-up for developing a spirit of academic co-operation with each other.

- 1. This agreement aims to promote academic cooperation and exchange of teaching and research experiences between Mahakaushal University (henceforth referred to as MKU) and the Bundelkhand University Jhansi (henceforth referred to as BUJ).
- 2. The two organizations shall cooperate in developing mutual interests on a reciprocal basis and respect for the independence and equal status of each organization.

3. Scope of MOU

This agreement details the terms & conditions, financial arrangements and modalities of collaboration that may involve intellectual property rights (IPR), and responsibilities and obligations of the MKU and BUJ, pertaining to the (i) Training/projects undertaken by the students of MKU and (ii) various courses offered by the MKU at Diploma, UG, PG and PhD levels (iii) to work for the New Education Policy-2020 and mutual credit transfer for the benefits of students.

4. RESPONSIBILITIES OF BUJ & MKU

- > BUJ, will allow Research scholars, UG & PG students of the MKU to visit its institutes/faculties from time to time with mutual consent and after due correspondence and permission from both the institutes. This includes the students of MKU may attend a few classes at BUJ as a part of their coursework after due correspondence and permission from both the institutes.
- With mutual consent and prior permission from and/or between the concerned institutes, students of the MKU may be allowed to do projects (as part of their curriculum) and short-term courses, internship programs during summer or Puja vacation or during semester-break.
- > BUJ may formally depute its faculty-members, whenever possible, to arrange special talks to a selected group of MKU students.
- > BUJ may organize seminar, workshop or conference at the MKU campus. In such cases the MKU will provide all the logistic support to the BUJ.
- > BUJ may invite the MKU for seminar, workshop or conference organized at its campus. In such cases, BUJ will provide all the logistics support to the MKU faculties and students except for the cost of travel, food and lodging.

- > Any other academic activities may be jointly organized by the BUJ & MKU like cohosting of workshops, seminars etc., after due consultation, assessment and mutual consent.
- > After prior approval from the respective authorities, the students of MKU may be permitted to do project works with BUJ faculties at BUJ during summer and puja vacations. In such cases the incidental cost of transport etc. of the MKU students shall be borne by the MKU, and vice-versa.

4. General Agreements

The two organizations agree to:

- a. Exchange academic materials and information;
- b. Visit of faculty members and research scholars, if possible;
- c. Students' internship program and credit transfer as per NEP 2020;
- d. Hold joint National & International conferences, workshops, seminars etc.;
- e. Conduct joint research project;
- f. Engage in the activities that could better mutual understanding and cooperation.
- g. To work together for implementation of NEP 2020.

5. FORCE MAJEURE

Neither the MKU nor BUJ shall be held responsible for non-fulfillment of their respective obligations under this agreement, due to the exigency of one or more of the force majeure events such as but not limited to acts of God, war, flood, earthquakes, strikes, lockouts, epidemics, riots, civil commotions etc., provided on the occurrence and cessation of any such event the parties affected thereby, shall give a notice in writing to the other party within one month of such occurrence or cessation. If the force majeure continues beyond six months, the parties shall jointly decide about the future course of action.

6. TERMIANTION OF AGREEMENT

This agreement may be terminated by either of the parties forthwith if either of them commits breach of any of the terms hereof and shall have failed to rectify such breach within thirty days of the notice in this behalf having been served on it by the other party i.e. either MKU or BUJ in correspondence; as the case may be. In addition to the above reasons, this agreement may be terminated forthwith if either of the parties voluntarily or involuntarily enters into official dilution, bankruptcy or similar recognizable proceedings or if, applications invoking such proceedings have been filed.

7. DURATION

This 'Memorandum of Understanding' shall remain valid for a period of five years from the date of signing of the MOU. After this, the MOU may be terminated or may be renewed after judging the then situation.

8. SETTLEMENTS

Upon termination of the agreement: All rights granted to BUJ and The MKU hereto, shall cease to exist forthwith; except the obligation of The MKU to keep

collaborative activity in confidence, accrued on or prior to the date of such termination, make written reports and keep records, files and books, and the right of BUJ to inspect the same.

8. AMENDMENTS TO THE AGREEMENT

No amendment or modification of this MOU shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by either the parties or their authorized representatives, specifically stating the amendment to this MOU. The modifications /changes shall be effective from the date on which they are executed; unless otherwise agreed to. In general, the MOU will be amended on yearly basis, IF AT ALL REQUIRED, on mutually agreed terms.

9. ASSIGNMENT OF THE AGREEMENT

The rights and/or liabilities of this MOU shall not be assigned except with the written consent of The MKU and BUJ, subject to such terms and conditions, as may be mutually agreed upon, by both the parties.

- 10. The details of this agreement are to be decided by mutual consultation between the two parties. Both parties understand that all terms and conditions of the above-mentioned activities as well as financial arrangements will have to be negotiated and established in separate written agreements.
- 11. This agreement is executed in English in two original copies and each party will retain one original copy.
