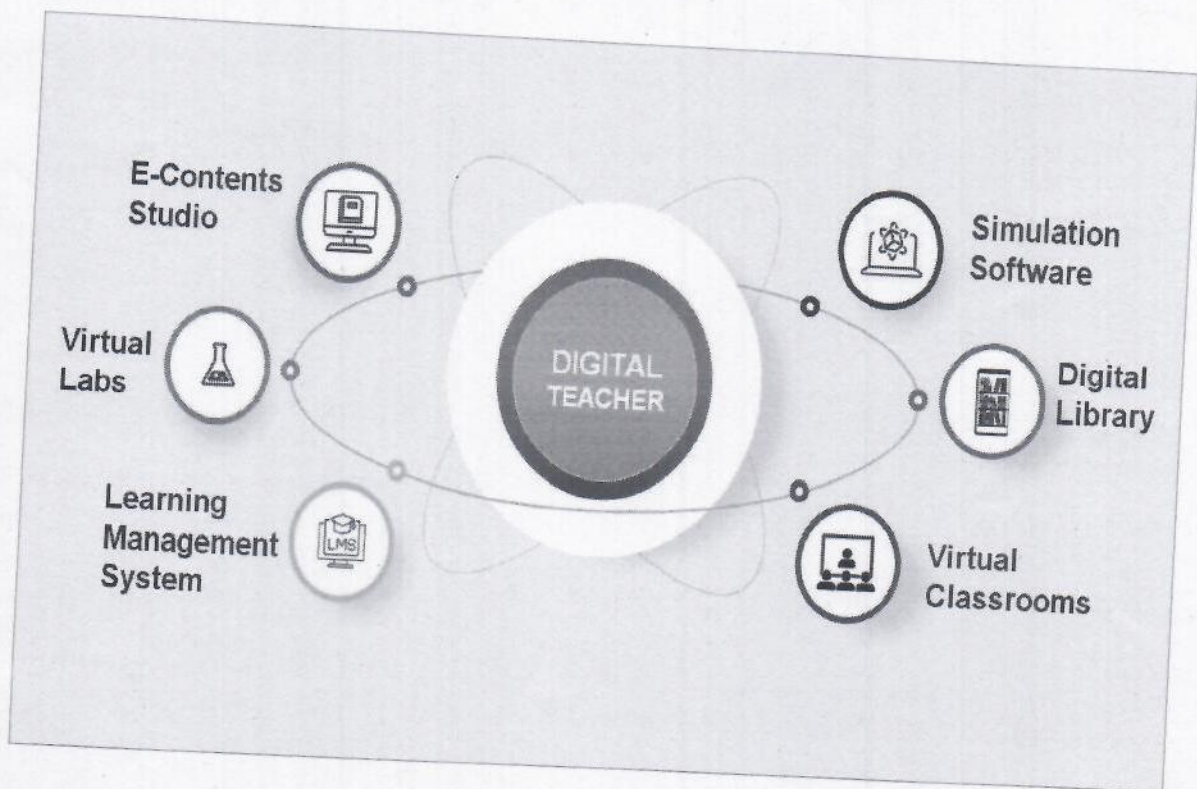
Academic Excellence through ICT

- ❖ Enhancing the mobilization of research grant and procuring more grants from related funding agencies in the field of Health Care,

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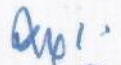
- Soil Testing, Climate Change, Environment conservation, Green Energy and Renewable Sources of Energy

Collaborations

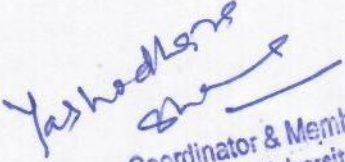
- ❖ Entering into collaborative arrangements with reputed academic institutions, research institutions and industry forums for creating opportunities for students and faculty

Globalization

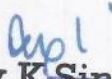
- ❖ Certification or Accreditation by International Rating Agencies.
